PUSD DELIVERS MEASURE TT PROJECTS

Pasadena, CA – Pasadena Unified School District (PUSD) has completed a number of significant school facilities improvement projects funded by the voter-approved Measure TT this summer, it was announced today at a meeting of the Board of Education's Facilities subcommittee. Completed work includes new artificial surface fields at John Muir High School and Pasadena High School.

"As our students return to school, they will see tangible improvements at their campuses that reflect the passionate support of our community, and our elevated expectations," said Superintendent Edwin Diaz. "A tremendous amount of projects were delivered on time and on budget."

The report, made at the meeting of the Board's facilities subcommittee, will also be presented at the next meeting of the Citizens Oversight Committee and is available at www.pusd.us.

Measure TT improvements will enhance academic, recreational and enrichment opportunities for PUSD students, while complementing the aesthetics of their surrounding neighborhoods.

Classrooms have been converted for an innovative, inclusionary preschool program at Loma Alta, where a new fire sprinkler enclosure was also completed. Willard Elementary received a new music and band room as well as a grass playfield. San Rafael will benefit from modernized and rehabilitated classrooms in preparation for the new Dual Immersion program.

Students and parents at a number of schools will note a number of improvements such as new ceiling tiles, roofing repairs and paint projects. New fencing has also been installed at Muir High School. New canopy and roofing projects at Rose City are 50 percent complete.

District-wide projects include new clocks, installed at 27 school sites, and energy-savings projects, which will cut District spending on utilities.

A total of approximately \$16 million in Measure TT work has been completed to date, or is underway, as are many deferred maintenance and smaller projects.
